What is expected from the competitors while they design the play area?

They are expected to create a play area that enables children to create various game fictions, to experience risk-taking and competing, and is open changes and development while reflecting the sub-theme they determined in the approximately 7000m2 area given by Cemer. Design should be innovative, modern, creative, environmentally sensitive, open to change and flexible, rather than a traditional, monotonous, uniform, stereotyped layout.

Natural data (topography of the land, the presence/absence of existing plants, climatic data, relations with the environment, etc.) and interventions to the site (changing the land form, placement of play equipment and urban furniture, structural and green elements to be added, roads designed for circulation control, informative and restricting signs to be placed etc.) that is, all inputs and outputs of the design should be considered from a holistic perspective.

### 3. Organizer of the Competition

The competition is organized by Cemer Kent Ekipmanları San. Tic. A.Ş.

### 4. Categories and Terms of Participation

Applications for the competition can be made individually or as a team. The applicant is expected to be a landscape architect for individual applications, and it is expected that there will be at least one landscape architect (landscape architect/landscape architect student) in the team for applications as a team. Both professionals and students can participate in the competition.

### 5. General Rules of Participation

The general participation rules for both student and professional categories are given in the following articles.

5.1. Competitors can participate in the competition in only

The 4th "Dreams Come True" Design Competition to be organized by Cemer aims to make existing and future urban living spaces more improved, more healthy, environmentally more valuable and redefine them on sustainability basis under the theme of "Breathing/Breathable Living Spaces".

## 2. Category

The theme is designing SUSTAINABLE PLAY AREAS for BREATHING/BREATHABLE LIVING AREAS.

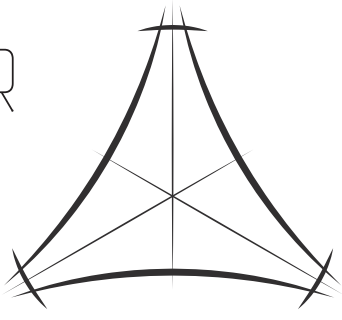
### 2.1. Subject

Creating healthy and sustainable environments is crucial for children's playgrounds that contribute to future generations. Nowadays, it is seen that the number and quality of children's playgrounds are gradually decreasing due to the increasing population, lost green areas and unplanned urbanization.

Children's playgrounds are important places that bring children together, meet their need to play, socialize, and contribute to their physical and psychological development. These places contribute to emotional, sensory perception and communication skills by making children feel good.

The most important principles for the success of these spaces are; designing the playground by considering the natural and physical characteristics of the area, considering the game fictions while designing the playground and making these fictions visible in the design, and handling this design together with the structural & green elements and the existing and designed form of the area in a holistic perspective.

Children Playgrounds should be correctly positioned, designed via using elements in harmony with nature, accessible to all children with or without disabilities, responding to the needs of the society, incorporating the differentiating play needs of different age groups and their



one category (student or professional) with maximum three different projects.

5.2. The competitors must register at [www.dustengercege.com](http://www.dustengercege.com) and the application period must be completed on the website.

5.3. Persons who are partners, employees or first-degree relatives of any of the employees of Cemer Kent Ekipmanları A.Ş. or members of the jury cannot participate in the competition.

5.4. For each project participating in the competition, these features are demanded: it has not been produced before, has not been made available to the public, has not been placed in a similar competition and has not been awarded. In case of nonconformity to the rules, the relevant project will be disqualified.

If such a project is determined, the prize will be taken back and rank will be canceled. If the projects submitted to the competition are not authentic and the third parties put in a claim for the design, the entire responsibility belongs to the competitor/competitors.

5.5. Students or Professionals may participate individually or as a team. Chamber membership document is required for the professionals.

5.6. It is required that the competitors have graduated from or studying a bachelor's or a master's program at any department of Fine Arts, Design and Architecture faculties of the universities or at any Landscape Architecture Department within other faculties.

5.7. In the case of a group application, at least one of the group members must fulfill the condition stated in Article 4. If the designs are not authentic and the third parties put in a claim for the design, the entire responsibility belongs to the competitor/competitors.

## 6. Participation Process

Applications to the competition shall be made on "www.dustengercege.com" web site in two stages and online. Online application is made on website by accepting the competition conditions (digital approval) and completing the application articles listed below on website.

6.1. First Stage: Creation of application account

The competitors must register their credentials in the system to create an application account. When the registration is complete, the application account will be created for competitors to upload their projects. Access to the application account will be made through the NICKNAME and ACCOUNT PASSWORD created by the system automatically. This information will be automatically sent to the e-mail address registered during application. When the competitors register their personal information in the system, they are deemed to have accepted all conditions stated in the competition conditions.

### 6.2. Project Submission

The project is submitted by uploading the visuals and design explanations using the application account.

6.3. There should be no signs or logos to indicate the identity of the competitor in the project sheets and written explanations. Otherwise, the project will be excluded from the project competition scope. Since the USERNAME for each application will be determined automatically by the system, the loaded sheets and texts will be directly matched with the USERNAME. Therefore, applicant information should not be added to the layouts by the designers.

6.4. Sheets should be listed as; 1/200 CONCEPT PROJECT(A), 2 SECTIONAL VIEW(B), VISUALS(C) and PROJECT REPORT(D).

A: Shall be as sheets in accordance with 1/200 scale drawing technique criteria (presentation technique is free).

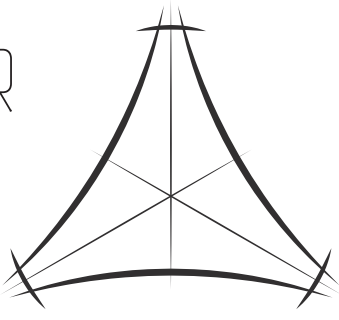
B: 2 pieces of 1/100 scale cross-sectional views taken from two angles that best describe the project is required.

C: These are 3D visuals that best describe the project.

D: Written text describing the design approach (500 characters), its innovative aspects (500 characters), and the application/production method and technical specifications (200 characters).

There is no limitation on the number of sheets.

6.5. Each sheet should have a resolution of 150dpi and a maximum size of 5mb and must be in a horizontal layout. The file extension must be in jpeg format. Project descriptions will be automatically placed by the system in the digital layout to be used in the jury evaluation.

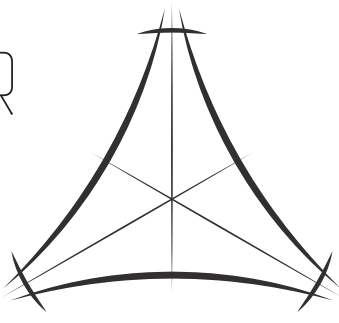

**10. Assessment Criteria**

10.1. The competition-participating projects will be assessed by the jury as a whole on these criteria: experience offered during playing, Innovativeness and Authenticity, Creativity, and Practicability, Sustainability, Effective Use of Field Topography and Other Field-Related factors, and other criteria based on these criteria that the jury may add during the assessment.

10.2. Pre-elimination will start when the projects are sent to the jury members and the projects that pass the pre-elimination will be assessed.

10.3. The jury assessment will be made on the date of jury meeting when the absolute majority is provided.

10.4. JAfter the first 3 prizes are determined by the jury, the honorable mentions will be awarded with the "public voting" system which will be opened on [www.dustengercege.com](http://www.dustengercege.com) website.

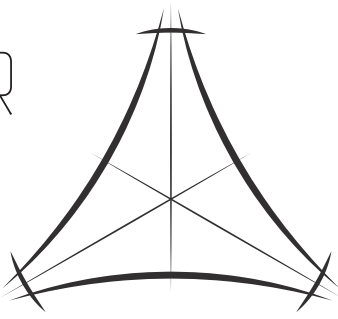
10.5. The design chosen for the honorable mention will be determined by the public voting.

### 11. Design Rights

11.1. In accordance with the Industrial Property Law, all designers participating in the competition have the right to apply to the Turkish Patent and Trademark Authority and get an "Industrial Design Registration Certificate" for their designs in order to protect their "new and distinctive" designs with which they participate. Participants interested in the application can access the necessary information at <http://www.tpe.gov.tr>.

11.2. The competition organizer Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. A.Ş. reserves the right to exhibit the participating designs which it deems worthy in different cities and countries. The competition organizer Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. A.Ş. will have the right to publish, archive and exhibit all projects participating in the competition at home and abroad indefinitely and without paying any price to the participant. On the other hand, it declares with this document to the participants that it will ensure the safety of the works and all documentation.

11.3. If a high ranking work in the competition within the scope of the project becomes a work to be protected within



the scope of the law no 5846 "Law of Intellectual and Artistic Works", the financial rights of the work, such as processing, reproduction, dissemination, representation, public transmission rights, and patent rights exclusively belong to the participant. If the competition organizer Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. A.Ş., wants to obtain a license for the use of these rights and/or industrial design rights for a certain period of time or to transfer such rights, it is necessary for them to make a contract with the participants and agree on the price to be paid. The participants accept by their participation in the competition that if Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. A.Ş. wants to take over the rights of the project, the amount to be paid for the related project within the scope of the agreement to be made with the participant is maximum **4000 EURO** for ranked projects and will not exceed **4000 Euro** for non-ranked projects. In addition, the participants have to offer the transfer and/or license rights first to Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. Inc. company in writing. If it does not find it appropriate, then the participant can present his projects to any company.

11.4. Participants of the competition must obtain the permission of all participants for commercial use. If the project organizer Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. A.Ş. deems appropriate, it may attempt to purchase the project in accordance with article 13.3.

11.5. In case the rights of competitors participating in the competition are being used by getting license or via transfer, the rights/moral rights of the competitors to demand for determination of their names as designers, owners or inventors according to the project subject are reserved.

11.6. The competition organizer Cemer Kent Equipment San. Tic. A.Ş. may produce one or more sample models to display the designs that it deems appropriate from the participating designs, and can display these models temporarily or permanently without paying any price to the participant.

11.7. Unless otherwise specified by the competitors, the names of the participants may be announced and published together with their projects. If the competitors demand during the application that their personal information not be announced; such projects will take place in the exhibition, booklets and catalogs to be created at the end of the competition, but will not include the name, contact information or photographs of the designers. This means that their identities are closed only to the media and the public. This does not mean that the identities are closed to the Competition Secretariat and Members of the Jury after the application uploading date. If the applicants do not demand

their personal information to be kept secret during application, the design owners will be included with their open identity at the exhibition to be organized, in booklets and catalogs to be created at the end of the competition.

#### 11.8. Personal Data Protection and Privacy

Definitions:

"Personal Data": Any information relating to an identifiable or identified natural person.

Processing of personal data: Any operation which is performed upon personal data such as collection, recording, storage, preservation, alteration, adaptation, disclosure, transfer, retrieval, making available for collection, categorization or blocking its use by wholly or partly automatic means or otherwise than by automatic means which form part of a filing system;

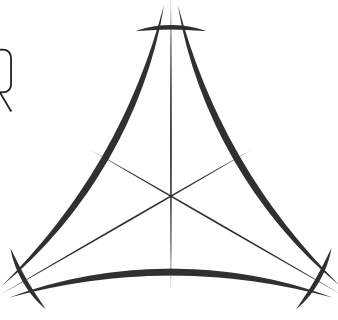
Data controller: Natural or legal person who determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data, and who is responsible for establishment and management of the filing system.

Third Person: Natural person whose personal data are processed by the data controller.

"Confidential Information": The parties accept, declare and undertake that the information that they obtain during the performance of the contract such as the trade secrets, R&D data or any other information or data that may lead to commercial gain or damage the other party in any way including loss of reputation will be used only for the purposes of this contract and that they will use and take all kinds of measures, including the undertaking of such information from the relevant personnel, and that they will not disclose such data and information to a third party without the written consent of the other party.

The identity (name and surname), professional experience (educational status, occupation/certificate information), communication data (telephone number, e-mail address), visual and audio recordings (photo) information of the participants can be transferred to Social Media or Group companies for storage by Cemer only for the purposes of Checking Compliance to Competition Conditions, Conducting Advertising/Campaign/Promotion Processes, Conducting Sponsorship Activities, Conducting Loyalty Processes for Companies/Products/ Services, Organization and Event Management, Conducting the Contract Process and within the scope of establishment and execution of the contract to be started upon the sending of CVs by the participants and jury member for as long as required for the abovementioned purposes.

In order to ensure that the transfer of Personal Data to be transferred by Cemer and Jury Members and Participants to each other is carried out in accordance with the law and to



prevent unauthorized access to such Personal Data by third parties and to take all necessary technical and administrative measures and to ensure confidentiality, all parties must act in accordance with the Law on Protection of Personal Data and related legislation.

The Participant or the jury members accept, declare and undertake that they shall not disclose the Confidential Information obtained from Cemer within the scope of the contract, keep it confidential, keep it secret, secure it, and will not disclose the confidential information in whole or in part to any third party or unauthorized person without Cemer's prior written consent.

The participant may not disclose the personal data he/she accesses to third parties against the provisions of Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data and this contract. The Participant shall take all necessary technical and administrative measures to ensure the appropriate level of security in order to prevent unlawful access to the Personal Data he/she accesses. These obligations continue indefinitely after the contract is terminated.

Cemer will keep the personal data it has processed for the period specified in the Personal Data Storage and Disposal Policy and will destroy it due to reasons such as expiration of the period, legal reasons, application of the person concerned, or lack of data processing reason. Cemer determines the Storage and Destruction Periods in compliance with the maximum storage periods specified in Law and the relevant legislation.

The obligations regarding Privacy and Protection of Personal Data within the scope of this contract shall continue to apply indefinitely, regardless of any time limitation of the commercial relationship between the Parties.

You may forward your requests and applications under Article 11 of the Law on Protection of Personal Data No. 6698 "regulating the rights of the person concerned" to Cemer.

11.9. The legal responsibilities arising from the fact that the designs participating in the competition are not authentic, do not bind Cemer Kent Ekipmanları San. Tic. A.Ş. All responsibility belongs to the competitor. In such cases, the prize of the competition is canceled, and the prizes taken back after necessary determinations. The canceled project and -if any- other applications of the competitor/s who apply for the competition with the project in question will be disqualified. If the project won a prize, this prize and -if any- all prizes that the competitor/s who apply for the competition with the project in question are demanded back by Cemer Kent Ekipmanları San. Tic. A.Ş. In the contrary case, the necessary legal remedies will be sought.

11.10. The number of the prizes and prize number conditions of the competition can be changed with the joint decision of Jury Committee and if it is deemed necessary in terms of utility of the competition.

11.11. If the prize amount received by the prize winner in the competition exceeds the tax exemption limit according to the laws of Republic of Turkey, the tax liability to be paid belongs to the relevant designer.
